ANNEX 1 - MANDATORY CONDITIONS

The Licence is granted on the condition that the restrictions contained within the enactments specified under Licensing Act 2003 schedule 8 (6) are adhered to:-

Children & Young Persons Act 1933
Cinematograph (Safety) Regulations 1955
Sporting Events (Control of Alcohol Etc) Act 1985

Licence granted subject to the following Mandatory Conditions:-

Where a Premises Licence authorises the supply of alcohol

1. That no supply of alcohol may be made under the Premises Licence:-
 - (a) At a time when there is no Designated Supervisor in respect of the Premises Licence, or
 - (b) At a time when the Designated Premises Supervisor does not hold a Personal Licence or his/her Personal Licence is suspended.
2. That every supply of alcohol under the Premises Licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a Personal Licence.

Exhibition of Films

1. Where a Premises Licence authorises the exhibition of films, the Licence must include a condition requiring the admission of children to the exhibition of any film to be restricted in accordance with these paragraphs.
2. Where the film classification body is specified in the Licence, unless paragraph 3(b) below applies, admission of children must be restricted in accordance with any recommendation by that body.
3. Where,
 - (a) The film classification body is not specified in the Licence or Certificate, or
 - (b) The Licensing Authority has notified the holder of the Licence which holds the Licence that this paragraph applied to the film in question, admission of children must be restricted in accordance with any recommendation made by the Licensing Authority.
4. In these paragraphs, 'children' means person aged under 18, and 'film classification body' means the person or persons designated as the authority under Section 4 of the Video Recordings Act 1984 (authority to determine suitability of video works for classification).

Door Supervision

1. Where a Premises Licence includes a condition that a specified times one or more individuals must be at the premises to carry out a security activity, the Licence must include a condition that each such individual must be licensed by the Security Industry Authority.

You are required to notify the Licensing Authority of any change in:

- 1) Name of the premises;
- 2) Alterations to premises;
- 3) A change of Designated Premises Supervisor;
- 4) A Designated Premises Supervisor not holding a valid Personal Licence;

- 5) Loss or theft of your licence (a fee will be required to cover the cost of issuing a replacement);
- 6) Any change to the hours or activities granted under this licence may require a Variation application. You are advised to discuss with the Licensing Authority;
- 7) The holder of the premises licence must ensure that the licence or a certified copy is kept at the premises in the custody or under the control of either the holder of the licence or a person who works at the premises and has been nominated in writing by the licence holder for this purpose;
- 8) The holder of the Premises Licence must ensure that the Summary of the licence or a certified copy of that Summary, and a Notice specifying the position held at the premises by any person nominated for the purposes of (7) above are displayed prominently at the premises.

ANNEX 2 - CONDITIONS CONSISTANT WITH OPERATING SCHEDULE

1. Staff to ensure that customers disperse without causing disturbance to residential property in the vicinity.
2. Staff to report evidence of any criminal activity taking place on the premises to the Management and Police as soon as practicable.
3. All electrical, fire detection/alarms/lighting, gas appliances and any other relevant plant and equipment to be maintained in good working order and tested for such as necessary. Records of such checks to be maintained at the premises.
4. Staff to ensure that there is no adverse impact or disturbance to other properties in the vicinity as a consequence of any licensable activity taking place at the premises.
5. Staff to be trained in their responsibilities with regard to alcohol sales and general safety of customers and staff within the premises.
6. If necessary to prevent under age drinking, introduce an appropriate proof of age identification scheme.
7. Maintain the external CCTV system, all recording to be continuous during opening hours and be date and time recorded. Recordings to be retained for a period of 21 days and be made available at all reasonable to a Police Officer or an authorised officer of the Council.
8. Prominent notices requesting customers to leave quietly to be displayed.
9. Bottles to only be disposed of outside the premises during the period 09:00hrs and 20:00hrs to reduce the likelihood of noise disturbance.
10. Alcohol sales and Late Night Refreshments permitted to residents (and bone fide guest of residents) outside of normal licensing hours (24hrs).
